

## MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF MEMORIAL HALL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Monday, February 10, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 4:10 p.m.

It was moved and seconded that the minutes be accepted as submitted.

Scott brought the board up to date on the status of the installation of the new furnace, noting that the building will continue to be without heat through the spring.

The Board Members brought up to Scott their concerns about the condition of the Hall when the new season begins with the Irish Festival on March 22, 2014. In particular the Board is concerned that there would be sufficient heat in the hall for the concert, that the basement/green room be cleaned and that the Hall itself.

Alan talked about the status of the Irish Dancers, as well as updating information on the upcoming performances by the acrobatic dancers, and stating that he was in negotiations with the puppet theater for a children's performance.

The Board discussed its submission to the Town Report. It was decided that we should express appreciation for the town's support for the hall, bring attention to the work being done as well as work that still needs to be done. It was agreed that the report should highlight the partnerships that have been developed with other town organizations and finally that there should be information about the number of people who come to the town to attend performances in the hall. The President stated that she would write the report and then send to members for their comments.
