

Wilmington Cemetery Commissioners meeting minutes

Intervale & Riverview Cemeteries

The Commissioners met at Riverview and Intervale for review of future and present maintenance to the cemeteries. At present time in Intervale there are several monuments in need of serious repairs the commissioners will be researching, writing and applying for grants for monument repairs then go out for bids to start the repair process.

With existing dangers of old trees, limbs in both cemeteries and the decaying vault in Intervale. A motion was made to have them removed due to the seriousness of the conditions all were in favor. The commissioners will make arrangements for removal of the limbs/trees and the structure of the vault while using the materials left to fill in any other repairs that are needed.

In Riverview – Future thoughts on repairs of a culvert, leveling of soil on an embankment and surveying of new plots before selling any more. There is a need of replacement for a few dying trees along the roadways. A new roof was added to the maintenance building.

The removal of a fence at the cemetery by the Wilmington transfer station will also be done.

Restland- Had the tree line cleared on the west side along the stone wall.
