- II. Middle School Summer Programming Discussion:

 - Counselor interviews will take place on April 30th with Wings staff

 - Top 3 director candidates will be interviewed
 - Director will be required to be finger printed and have a background check
 - We have \$450 left in the FY15 budget for supplies
 - DVCP will continue offering one extended day per week.
 - Randy will continue after camp programming similar to last year (rock climbing, paddling)
- III. Elementary School Summer Programming Discussion:
 - Jamie Brown will continue as the Director
 - Celebrate Summer Program will run for 4 weeks-July 6-31
 - Counselor interviews will be on April 30th at 3:30pm at TVMHS
 - Budget for Elementary Program will include salary for Jamie Brown, \$2446 (past amount allocated minus revenue) for the Wings program to cover counselors, and \$700 for supplies
 - Town of Whitingham approved a contribution of \$1700 to the program, so Wilmington and Whitingham residents will receive a discount on cost.
