# Bi Town Committee Regular Meeting Minutes Wilmington Town Offices July 2, 2015

Meeting was called to order by Ken Black at 8:08 AM. On a motion by Heidi Taylor, seconded by Diane Chapman, the minutes of June 4, 2014 were approved by unanimous vote.

## **Topics Discussed**

#### Digital Marketing

- Marketing plan was changed to 3 years out
- Dover Selectboard presentation to be held on Tuesday, July 7, 2015
- Wilmington Selectboard to be held on Wednesday, July 8, 2015
- 2 year's plus funding to be spread out over 3 years to take into account startup initiatives and timing for summer/fall target marketing
- Funding will be quarterly, in advance, on a pro-rated basis as services are required
- Chamber of Commerce Executive Director will be on the committee as a nonvoting member but paid a small administration fee

#### Telecommunications

- Vtel indicates that the Rice Hill antennas inn Dover will become operational by the end of Summer 2015
- Instead of running fiber to the tower, Vtel will be using a microwave link from Mount Snow
- Bandwidth and cost initiatives are still unknown, but 40 Mbps was speculated as a possible maximum
- Discussions have been proposed to initiate a meeting with Vtel management regarding expansion of wireless bandwidth within the valley on a partnership basis
- Vtel is charging \$70 per month for 1 Gbps and \$400 per month for 10 Gbps service in some areas based on fiber to the home
- Vtel reconfirmed the cost of \$25,000 per mile to lay fiber.

- The Haystack Gatehouse to Wilmington section will be assessed by wetlands representatives on July 9, 2015
- There are 19 areas of wetlands concerns
- If significant wetlands issues exist, state might need to reclassify portions of the trail
- o Sur-Pak and culvert evaluation will take place as well
- o Jake White mowed 1st section of trail in Wilmington
- Mowing should take place 2 3 times per year at 2 hours each
- o State can divert path of trail if conditions are egregious

### Wilmington

- Façade program having a slow start \$75,000 allocated
- Bike/Pedestrian grant to be submitted by July 17, 2015 to repair E. Main St sidewalk and retaining wall
- Parking issues with new businesses
- Mangia e Beve, the Italian restaurant on Route 9 to open soon
- 2 hour parking limit not strictly enforced at this time
- Bridge repair, east of the light was done by Wilmington as the state did not fund the project
- Business Consultant was hired to help area businesses feedback is very positive

## o **Dover**

- Bike/Pedestrian grant being applied for by July 17 for a scoping study to extend the Valley Trail along the state right of way from the West Dover Firehouse to the South Access Road at Mount Snow
- Dover concert series is beginning every Sunday in July and August from 1 – 3 PM at the Dover Park
- Right of Way certificate issued for section A of the Dover sidewalk project
- Final and contractor plans being reviewed by Vtrans
- Contractor advertising should occur later this year or early January

### Mount Snow

- West Lake water project going well
- Traffic Issues occurring as to when use of Coldbrook Rd is possible
- Some cars are speeding on Coldbrook Road in the construction area

- Need for volunteers
