### Minutes for August 13, 2015

#### Changes to Agenda:

1. Leslie Frasier made a request for the trails committee to provide guidance to 10 volunteers from her office who wished to spend a day working on the Wilmington Trails. It was determined that Crista Gannon would work with the Sotheby's team on September 3<sup>rd</sup>.
2. Haystack Trail: Jake led a group of 18 hikers up the Haystack Trail as part of the Blueberry Festival.

**Approve Minutes:** Crista Gannon made the motion to accept the minutes for July 9th, 2015. Jake White seconded, all approved.

**Update on Valley Trail:** Jake White and John Gannon will be meeting with representatives from the state at 7:30 am on August 14<sup>th</sup> to walk the Wilmington portion of the trail and assess it.

#### Update on Other Trails and Trail Work:

1. The Hoot, Toot and Whistle Trail: We will need to put gravel in at the "trail head" area between the bridge and the DVTA portion of the path. Gravel, Culvert, roller and truck are needed. The group discussed funding options.
2. Primitive Trail: John has cleared some fallen trees from the trail
3. Shearer Hill Trail: Bob Fisher will do some clearing on this trail
4. Riverwalk Trail: Discussion to prioritize maintenance activities for September 3<sup>rd</sup> volunteers. Discussion about remaining light which needs to be installed.
