Summer Flower Program/Landscaping

<u>Gateway Garden</u>: We are unable to assess winter damage to the garden yet. <u>West Main Street Parking Lot</u>: Lee advised that there is still snow/ice and gravel from snow plowing on the berm. Annual maintenance will be required to remove the gravel. Whatever is planted will need hardy and as close to maintenance free as possible. One possibility for the sunny sections is no-mow grass which only requires one weed-whacking in the fall; ferns might be a good solution for shadier areas.

Community Garden

Mary Wright asked about plans for a community garden. Several possible locations were mentioned. Mary and Karen Horton will evaluate them and report back. The most promising locations are Howe field - good soil, potential water in well - and behind the high school. Once a location is identified, they will try to have the soil prepared by November.
