Primitive Trail: Spencer Crispe has been unable to reach one land owner for permission to incorporate her property in the trail system. Since there is snowmobiling access across said property, it was suggested that Spencer contact Barb Yanke and check with her about the current address for the landowner. John Green agreed to deliver permission forms to Al Wurzberger, Dave Mack and Don Wickstrom. Spencer will do the same for Tomas, Selei and Gereghty.

Lake Raponda Trail: John Green will speak to Mrs. Weil about the collapsed roof on her well. Ryan Edwards and Joe Arnold have not had a chance to relocate the bridge that was displaced by Irene to its former site leading to Stearns Avenue.

The meeting ended with a discussion of future foot paths out of the downtown area. There was also a discussion about the Bi-Town Committee and its interest in connecting Wilmington trails with Dover trails.
