Raponda Primitive Trail: John Greene and Spencer Crispe reconfigured the trail near the Gereghty property with Mr. Gereghty. They marked the trail with orange "ribbon". All present reviewed the tax maps and earmarked the residents that have not returned permission slips. Spencer Crispe will try to reach the Sellei family for their permission.

Hoot, Toot and Whistle Trail: We continue to wait for final permission to proceed in certain areas on the trail. John Greene obtained Mr. Erhard's permission to do trail work in his area. We will begin work on this section this Saturday between 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. John Greene received permission from Newkirk to use empty poles for bridges across wet areas. We will continue to do trail work on sections that are not designated "wetlands".

Valley Trail: Jake White showed us the new "Valley Trail" signs. The first section of the trail should be completed in a day or so. Jake White will make a cut near the Pilcher property and secure it. We will need a kiosk in this area.

Kiosks: John Gannon will speak to Travis about making kiosks. There was a discussion about placement of kiosks along the Valley Trail and the Hoot, Toot and Whistle Trail.

Parking Lot: We should receive parking lot lights in 4-6 weeks.

Maps: Jason Saltman will need GPS mapping for new maps.
