## TOWN OF WILMINGTON 2015 ANNUAL TOWN SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETING MINUTES MARCH 3, 2015

At 12:15pm the Moderator declared the meeting open and noted that the polls for voting and Article I for the Town and Town School District Meeting opened at 7a.m. until 7:00p.m. In attendance; School Board Members Phil Taylor, Dennis Richter, Janna Ewart, Adam Grinold; Town Clerk or Assistant Town Clerk; members of the Wilmington Board of Civil Authority; Election Officials; Poll Workers and about 25 voters.

## **ARTICLE II:**

DISCUSSION TOPICS (including but not limited to): thank you for hard work on getting essentially 2 new schools open; asking how school user fees work in coming year; board has reviewed what was listed in user fees; the former high school building going away relative to user fees when ownership is transferred; elementary school can be utilized more; school board and Selectboard should start discussing user fees; asked about re-establishment of music program and positions that were cut; voter was referred to the administrators; one music educator in each building is not sufficient to meet the needs of the levels of students: music program has been diminished; what is extraordinary special education costs and has any thought been given to utilizing other specialized schools to take the burden off this district; the district does outsource certain students to best meet their needs; district tries to serve special education needs in house because it's more cost effective; asked about comments regarding the new middle high school that it's not yet a year old and it's falling apart; discussion of amount of reimbursement for special education per student; discussion of per pupil cost to educate and tuition pricing; if you own a school you're paying more than if you are sending students out; where are Superintendent and Business Manager – they had to be in Whitingham and Halifax: both Christopher Pratt and Karen Atwood are doing remarkable job; discussion about pre-k program in coming year
