

Permit Application for Wilmington Town Highway or Street Temporary Closure

Except as specified in Title 23 section § 1010 (see below) the Police Chief and Town Manager (or designees) may approve a temporary closing of a town road (less than 5 days). Person seeking such a road closing must complete permit application and if issued permit is valid for only the dates and times approved. Any conditions specified must be followed or the permit may be revoked. Applicant is responsible to close approved road section with appropriate barriers and the Town with this permit assumes no liability for the applicant, applicant's employees, or any equipment or vehicles.

Title 23 Section § 1010 Special Occasions; Town Highway Maintenance

(a) When it appears that traffic will be congested by reason of a public occasion or when a town highway is being reconstructed or maintained or where utilities are being installed, relocated, or maintained, the legislative body of a municipality may make special regulations as to the speed of motor vehicles, may exclude motor vehicles from certain public highways and may make such traffic rules and regulations as the public good requires. However, signs indicating the special regulations must be conspicuously posted in and near all affected areas.
