Introductions were made. Explanations of the Flood and Fluvial Hazard Regulations were reviewed by Cheryl.

John Broker-Campbell presented a Power Point explaining the River Corridors and Flood Plain. The maps that are on the Town web-site were shown. They were also available in hard copy for townspeople to view.

He explained flooding damage causing erosion and instability.
