Scheduled Agenda:

- 1. <u>Minutes</u>: Motion to accept September 10, 2020 minutes by Bob F. with second by John Gannon. All in favor.
- 2. **Public Participation**: none
- 3. Discussion on Fairview Avenue traffic and speeding concerns. Bob shared information on a traffic study done on Fairview Avenue for parking and pedestrians walking on the road. The speed limit is to change from 30 mph to 25 mph. Possibly No Parking signs for the gate to the picnic area because the road is too narrow. - 5. Hunting Season Signs: Jake White had sent an email to consider posting signs "Hunting Season" (from September to December). John spoke of having appropriate wear. Knowing one's location was important maybe having signs on the kiosks "You are here."
- 6. Review of Finances for next meeting if any work may need to be done and how we stand with budget if materials are needed.
- 7. Trail Concerns on Ware Road area. Tire marks and ruts were seen. Committee reviewed trail map and the highway map seeing it could be marked Class 4 Highway Road "impossible of untravellable" designation. No posted signs would prevent use.
- 8. <u>Next Work Bee:</u> The calendar indicates October 22, 2 weeks after the regular meeting. Alan will contact "Friends of the Trails" to see if anyone noticed any trail that may need attention.
