6. Efficiency Vermont

 Becca White discussed Efficiency Vermont's Target Communities Effort. There are offers for Wilmington, Wardsboro, Whitingham, Dover and Jacksonville electric customers. Residents can get a virtual home energy audit; businesses can also get an energy audit– specialized incentives for different types of businesses; renters and landlords can receive free light bulbs and other similar items; funding for non-profits; municipalities can receive incentives for energy efficiency upgrades up to \$4000.
