 - a. Gretchen: Working with Sen Sanders office on an earmark for water/sewer Rt 9 East project. Selectboard to discuss municipal ARPA funds and taking suggestions at June 21 meeting. Cannabis retail sales revote passed. Safety Facility Grand Opening June 25. Beaver Street Art Project June 18 opening.

VIII. Dover update:

- a. Vicki: Had a dog issue in Dover, the Board made a ruling and the owner appealed to the VT Supreme Court and the Town won and our enforcement was upheld. Pupil weighting new legislation passed after a long battle we put both money and personnel towards.
- b. Eric: DOIT applications closed on May 31 with most we've ever had. Working with Village Center district businesses on tax credit applications. Finishing framework on Dover Technical Assistance Program. Helping non profits with some family activities: Library Story Walk, Dover School and

Living History Association historical driving tour. Close to finishing up Town Forest dedication to Phil Bartlett. Getting through RFP process for Horace Hill waiting on maps to use.

IX. Mount Snow update:

a. Brian: Golf course open for a few weeks now. Mountain biking and scenic lift rides open Fri-Sun now through October plus extra days for Labor Day and 4th of July. Friday afternoon block parties through summer. Old lift terminals are out, still some towers left to finish. Waiting on rebar.

X. Hermitage Club update:

a. Focused on snowmaking system maintenance and upgrades, Snocat storage building started. Around 125 working days until next season.

XI. BDCC update:

a. Adam: Hosted SoVT Economy Summit at Grand Summit. Meg Staloff stepped in to help coordinate that with Sarah Lang's departure and it was seamless. Attendees from all over the state. Dover's Town Meeting wrapped up our SeVeds funding requests. 89% of Windham county residents served through Municipal funding request. About 55 refugees employed now and we do anticipate a new group in the coming months, likely not from Afghanistan. Have retained that group and also seeing additional refugees come here from their initial relocation. Pitch Events for Business Plan Competition coming at Trail 87. Brattleboro, Londonderry and Bellows Falls locations also in June leading up to enrollment for the competition taking place in October. Focused on growth and scale but not limited to that. Lending and technical assistance updates: continuing to see an increase in interest in lending. We're supporting several businesses in the valley right now through that and also several through technical assistance. A reminder there is dedicated staff for that, Eyad Salha. He's helping them understand COG and Balance Sheets. Would love referrals for that including those businesses that have trouble accessing funding.

XII. Chamber update:

a. Bethaney: Prepping for Fireworks on July 2nd, Golf Tournament onJuly 25th and Blueberry Festival July 29- August 7. Wine and Harvest in September. Were able to change state special event permits so not affecting just us but all large alcohol including events. Restarted mixers at Trail 87 with 1a Coffee. Next one June 16 at Vermont Distillers celebrating Natural History Museum 25th anniversary, pushing out businesses as much as possible on social media platforms. Growing our memberships which is great, including FoodConnects coming in from Brattleboro.

XIII. Moover update:

a. Christine: starting to recruit for winter seasonal employees again. Changes in CDL program through us, can still offer but will take longer now.




