With the start of school our numbers are relatively flat. The "regular" storytime kids are attending Beaver Brook Preschool this year. I have coordinated with the director and teacher of the youngest kids so they come for our regular storytime. Right now they are bringing half the group one week and the other half the following week. After the first of the year they will most likely come twice a month with the whole group. I have begun posting storytime on our Facebook page again and have a poster at the entrance. The older group from Beaver Brook is coming once a month.

The library at the elementary school is not open to the kids this year yet. Tricia and I will not be able to work together on the Golden Dome Program as we usually do. I am thinking of offering an older kids' read-aloud time once a week after school. I will incorporate some of these books. I haven't yet set dates and program description. I am trying to build new programs to increase library use.

We picked names from those signed up for summer reading to receive Bartleby's gift certificates. There was one name picked from each of four age categories. All gift certificates were picked up quickly and made for some pleased participants.

I attended the Youth Services meet-up hosted here at Pettee. There were a total of five attendees. We talked about our programs and ideas for increasing library visitation.

I have been working on putting together seven backpacks filled with thematic books and activities. The hooks are installed so we can have them check-out ready soon. I'll put a notice up on Facebook letting kids know they're available.

Allison and I are beginning to plan a double feature movie Hocus Pocus and Hocus Pocus 2 between our two libraries. No date has been set.

I will be away October 8-19. Jennifer will be covering storytime. On October 9 I've set up a visit to the firehouse since Fire Safety Week is Oct 8-14. The following week we will have storytime at the library as usual.

I plan to offer a couple of short term after school programs and a couple of family programs. I hope we can continue the DIY programming also.
