 There has been a lot of good feedback about our new and renewed programs! We have had locals and visitors come for our programs and it has allowed us to get new patrons in the door that have not been to the library before, like at our Crafternoon and Silent Book Club events.

- Both the Annual Report and our application for a Fiber Grant are being finalized to be submitted this week. Also, the furnace was cleaned on November 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- The Poetry Party kicked off again in November with 5 in attendance. Jennifer and the group have discussed the possibility of placing poems for another poetry walk and that is well under way.
- We had an attendance of 9 at our November Book Club meeting to discuss *Wish You Were Here* by Jodi Picoult. December 20<sup>th</sup> we will meet to discuss *The House in the Cerulean Sea* by TJ Klune.
- The Friends have been busy collecting donations for raffle baskets for the upcoming American Flatbread fundraiser scheduled for January 23, 2024. They have taken on the dog waste station in front of the library and will be picking up each Tuesday in conjunction with their shelving schedule. For our plastic recycling initiative, we have collected 156lbs of plastic bags towards our goal of 500lbs for a park bench. The notice in the newsletter and on Facebook have helped tremendously.
- I attended a Wilmington Works board meeting in November and got to know more about the group and their goals for the town. I will continue to participate in the Promotions committee in the future to help plan town events and promote library programs.
- The Meet and Greet went well on the first of December, and I was able to meet new people and learn more about the Friends in attendance. Afterwards, I was also contacted by Lauren Harkawik about an introductory article for the Deerfield Valley News, which came out this week.
- I have been in contact with a representative from the Catamount Library Network. They have given me a lot of information about how the group is managed, costs, and a list of recommendations to be able to join in the future. I can present this opportunity further at our meeting.
