Overview

Property Transfer Tax is a tax on the transfer of title to real property in Vermont. The tax applies to both property transfers by deed and to acquisitions of a controlling interest in an entity with title to a property.

How to File and Pay

Please note when recording a

deed: Complete <https://tax.vermont.gov/document/2022-form-ptt-172>

Vermont Property Transfer Tax Return with identification numbers and one additional copy with the ID number redacted. Deliver the deed(s) and return to the town clerk. The clerk will record the deed(s) and they will send the copy(ies) with the identification numbers to the Department.

Payments

If tax is due at the time of transfer by deed, please make checks payable to the Vermont Department of Taxes and complete [Form PTT-173, Property Transfer Payment Voucher](#) and send to:
