MINUTES

Called to order at 5:04pm by John Gannon. No changes to the agenda and no public comment.

No minutes were available from August 20, 2024, for approval. John to check with Christine Richter.

Lenny asked what the Selectboard's response was to properties presented. The response was minimal as none of the properties have been identified as being currently on the market.

John said that he felt it was time to dissolve the committee, that there did not seem to be a consensus on the properties presented and a lot of time was spent on having the offices remain where they are. This initiative is also dropped in priority with the needs of the expansion of water/sewer to the East side of town, a need for a new well to the East and land acquisition for that, what may happen to Wheeler's Farm, and need for flood mitigation.

Bonnie would like to keep researching for river corridor and floodplain information from the state, and that is easier to do when on a committee. Asked about meeting every other month through the summer to continue with some details.

The committee has lost two members who have moved out of town.

John will propose dissolution at the subsequent Selectboard meeting.
