- 1. Agenda additions or deletions None.
- 2. Approval of minutes from 11/4/24 Motion to approve as written, by SK second by SM, all in favor.
- 3. Winter Activities Liability forms for Friday & Sunday night indoor soccer at OSEC have been turned in. SK to update calendar with game dates. There are no Recreation Commission events happening every day of the week. Tot Time is showing fluctuating attendance numbers. Julie can no longer run the program; SK has been standing in for her. SK will continue to serve as interim Tot Time facilitator until a replacement can be found.
- 4. Summer Planning Jenn N intends to return to the Rec Camp for the summer 2025 program. SM to reach out to previous counselors regarding coming back to work the 2025 program. SM is looking at staffing for the upcoming program, possibly running 2 directors, 2 counselors, and 1 counselor in training. It's been found that the application and interview process may be cumbersome. Candidates have to interview with both Wings and Rec Comm staff. Regarding summer camp swim days, there must be at least 1 licensed lifeguard on duty. Grants have been applied for to cover cost of possible swimming lessons. Splash pad/ice skating rink	Skate park
More shaded areas	More seating

In addition to the above ideas, SM to develop a survey to assess what community is looking for in their park. It should be remembered that some of the park is considered within the flood zone. Perhaps timing for completion of a major improvement project should be coordinated with the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary program.
