



Spring 2025 Bicycle/Sport Helmet Program

Over 400 winter and summer helmets have already been provided to kids in our community through this program.



The Wilmington Police Department has recognized a need to promote helmet safety in the community due to a large number of children without helmets. To help address this safety concern The Wilmington Police Department is again coordinating a free bicycle/sport helmet program. The program utilizes a helmet manufacturer selected by *SafeKids VT* that has agreed to sell helmets at their cost. This program is limited to students enrolled in grades K-5 at Twin Valley Elementary School or K-5 homeschool students.

The programs goal is get every child a helmet and educate them about helmet safety. In order to accomplish this goal the helmets in the attached brochure are free for families. This program is annually sponsored by the Freemasons of Social Lodge #38 who generously cover the costs of the helmets for this program.

Attached is a (1) page brochure of helmets to choose from, (1) page sizing guide and a (1) page order form. We ask that you order one helmet per child and only order if a helmet is needed as funds are limited.
