

The Wilmington Energy Committee minutes for its meeting of January 20, 2026, held at 3 PM in the Fire Department conference room in the Public Safety building at 40 Beaver Street in Wilmington Vermont. The meeting started at 3:05 PM with all in attendance with the exception of Chief Moore.

#### 1. Changes to the agenda and approval of December 16, 2025 minutes

There were no changes to the agenda and the minutes were approved unanimously by motion on Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Dix.

#### 2. Public participation

There was no participation from the public.

#### 3. Discussion on the Wilmington Enhanced Energy Plan - Anand Fedele WRC

Mr. Fedele discussed the results of an energy priority survey, he started a review of the Energy Chapter in the 2018 Town Plan and gave a short presentation on Wilmington comprehensive energy data. Committee members who didn't complete the survey and review the Energy Chapter in the 2018 plan were asked to do so before our next meeting. Mr. Fedele was asked to coordinate the development of the Enhanced Energy plan with the development of Larger Town Plan with the WRC town coordinator.

#### 4. Solar system install for Public Safety Building - update Bob Bois

Mr. Bois gave a short status summary on the Solar System project. The Selectboard voted to support a Town Meeting article and approved a funding vehicle for the project. The Town Manager has completed a draft of the RFP for the project. The project will need TM approval before moving forward.

#### 5. Window/Dresser - update Bob Bois

Mr. Bois gave a short summary on the hybrid program. The members from Rotary and the WEC will participate in the program with one change - Bennington will provide the Coordinator Measurer for the upcoming season. The Wilmington group will continue to coordinate their effort with the Window/Dresser group, from Bennington.

6. Botton-Up program - update Alex Miller

Mr. Miller contacted program staff. Mr Miller was ask to contact the Program next fall to schedule events.

7. Town Building Date collection - update Keith Johnson

Mr. Johnson has completed the spreadsheet for building electricity and has included the solar data. He will continue his effort to collect heating fuel data.
