

Wilmington Energy Committee minutes for meeting on Tuesday February 17 2026

1. Changes to the agenda and approval of January 20, 2026 minutes

The meeting was opened by the chair at 3 PM. All members were in attendance with the exception of Mr Dix. Mr Miller, Johnson, Moore, Carver, Bois, and Humenik were in attendance. Chief Moore left at approximately 3:30 to attend to other matters. There were no changes to the agenda.

2. Public participation

There were two members of the public who were in attendance by ZOOM. They were Jessica Lee Smith and a gentleman from Florida. Both expressed support for solar installs in Wilmington and offered to help in anyway.

3. Discussion on the Wilmington Enhanced Energy Plan - Anand Fedele WRC

Mr. Anand present a revised draft of the Current Energy Use for the Wilmington Enhanced Energy Plan. The revised draft summarized the Town's annual energy consumption as of 2023. Data for the document was provided by various sources; Green Mountain Power, Efficiency Vermont, WRC and various state and trade groups. The numbers were a mix of estimates and real data. The electricity segment numbers were measured while the transportation and the thermal segments were estimates. The group talked about getting better numbers for the two estimated segments. The group was surprised by the rather large total estimate cost to town residents for the three energy segments, roughly \$11.96 million annually. Various members are reviewing the status of Task goals found in the 2018 energy plan and looking to recommend new Energy Tasks for the Enhanced Energy Plan. Mr Fedele suggested the Committee can finalize the update energy use section and start discussions of new energy policies for the Enhanced Energy Plan at its next meeting.

4. Solar system install for Public Safety Building - update Bob

Mr Bois gave a short update on the solar project for the Public Safety building. A TM vote on funding the project is schedule for March 3, 2026 by Australian Ballot from 7AM to 7PM.

5. Window/Dresser - update Gary

Mr. Carver will continue to look for a volunteer to fill the critical position of Coordination Measurer for the program.

6. Town Building Date collection - update Keith

Mr Johnson is asking for help from the propane and fuel oil distributors the Town uses for heating its builds.

7. New items

There were no new items to discuss. The meeting was close at 4:45 PM by motion from. Mr Johnson with a second by Mr Carver. The vote was unanimous to end the meeting. The next meeting is scheduled for March 17, 2026 at 3 PM in the fire conference room at the Public Safety building.
